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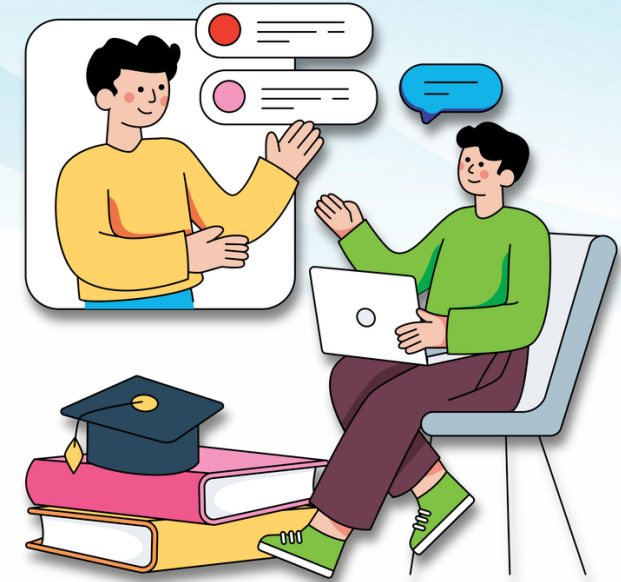

General Awareness

Questions in this section test the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to society. The exam also includes questions related to India and its neighbouring countries, especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General policy and scientific research.

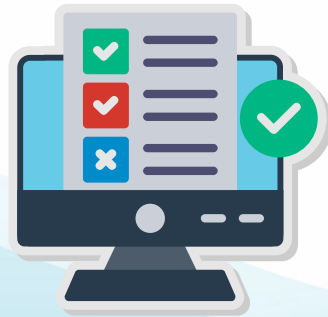
